

POVIJEST TRAKOŠĆANA

Ne zna se tko je i kada sagradio Trakoščan. Nastao je vjerojatno na samom početku 14. stoljeća kao manja utvrda u tadašnjem obrambenom sustavu sjeverozapadne Hrvatske. Njegovo ime se prvi put spominje 1334. godine u popisu župa (ecclesia de Tracustian), dok se Trakoščan kao utvrda spominje 1399. godine u darovnici kralja Sigismunda. Trakoščan je bio jedan od najvećih feudalnih posjeda u Hrvatskoj, a punih 400 godina bio je u vlasništvu obitelji Drašković.

Današnji izgled dvorca potječe iz sredine 19. stoljeća, kada je podmaršal grof Juraj VI. Drašković obnovio ruševan srednjovjekovni grad i pretvorio ga u udoban i raskošan dvorac. Dvorac je obnovljen u neogotičkom stilu, a paralelno s obnovom dvorca odvijali su se i radovi na pregradnji doline i stvaranju umjetnog jezera, kao i uređenje okolnog romantičarskog perivoja.

Dvorac je danas uređen kao muzej, koji je zajedno s neposrednim okolišem zaštićen kao kulturno dobro RH. Kulturno dobro je ujedno i sastavni dio šire zaštićene prirodne cjeline park-šume Trakoščan.



THE HISTORY OF TRAKOŠČAN

It is unknown exactly who built Trakoščan or when it was constructed. Most likely it came to existence at the very beginning of the 14th within the defensive system of Northwest Croatia. Its name was first mentioned in 1334 in the register of parishes (ecclesia de Tracustian), while Trakoščan as a fortress was first mentioned in 1399-in King Sigismund's grant. Trakoščan used to be one of the largest feudal properties in Croatia, and stayed in the possession of the Drašković family for 400 years.

The castle's present appearance dates back to the middle of the 19th that time, the deputy marshal, count Juraj VI Drašković had restored the dilapidated medieval city and turned it into a comfortable and luxurious castle, reconstructed in neo-Gothic style. The castle's reconstruction also included work on redeveloping the valley and creating an artificial lake, as well as work on designing the surrounding Romanticist garden.

Today, the castle has been transformed into a museum, which is protected as cultural heritage of the Republic of Croatia, together with the adjacent surroundings. The cultural heritage is also a component of a wider protected natural complex of Trakoščan Park Forest.

PARK-ŠUMA I PERIVOJ

Šumovito područje oko Trakoščanskog jezera, koje se prostire od jugozapadne do sjeveroistočne strane dvorca Trakoščan, dio je zaštićene prirodne cjeline park-šume Trakoščan. To je jedna od najljepše formiranih parkovnih cjelina bogate vegetacije i zanimljivih vizura, koja pruža jedinstveni doživljaj netaknute prirode.

Parkovni prostor oko dvorca Trakoščan tipičan je primjer romantičarskog perivoja iz sredine 19. stoljeća, koji se do danas očuvao u gotovo izvornom obliku. Perivoj se dijelom razvio iz autohtone šume hrasta kitnjaka i običnog graba, od koje su do danas ostali sačuvani pojedinačni primjeri starih hrastova. U njemu su posadene različite egzotične vrste drveća, koje kroz godišnja doba mijenjaju kolorističku sliku perivoja. Osobito i prepoznatljivo obilježje daje mu veliko umjetno jezero, dugo oko dva kilometra, čija površina iznosi oko 23 hektara.



PARK-FOREST AND GARDEN

A forested part of the park and lake extending from the southwestern to the northeastern side of the castle, and it is a protected natural area. It is one of the most beautifully formed park units, with rich vegetation, interesting panoramas, offering a unique experience of untouched nature.

Trakoščan garden is a typical example of a Romanticist garden of the mid-19th century, which has been almost completely preserved to its original form. The garden was partly developed from the indigenous forest of sessile oak and common hornbeam. Today, single specimens of old oaks have been preserved. There are various exotic tree species planted in the garden, which change the coloristic garden structure throughout the different seasons. A distinctive and recognizable characteristic of Trakoščan is the large artificial lake, which is about two kilometres long and covers the surface of around 23 hectares.

TRAKOŠČAN



JEZERO

Trakoščansko jezero je umjetna akumulacija, koja je nastala izgradnjom brane sredinom 19. stoljeća u okviru romantičarske obnove cijelog trakoščanskog kompleksa. Prema kartografskoj građi već je i ranije postojala manja vodena površina, vjerojatno umjetno izgrađen ribnjak na području gornjeg dijela sadašnjeg jezera.

Jezero prima vodu iz potoka koji se sливaju niz obronke okolnog gorja, među kojima je najznačajniji potok Čemernica. Od samog nastanka jezero je imalo dvojaku funkciju: gospodarsku - kao ribnjak, te estetsku - kao dekorativni element koji je uobičajen u romantičarskoj parkovnoj arhitekturi. Iza brane voda iz Trakoščanskog jezera teče kao potok, te utječe u rijeku Bednju.



LAKE

Lake Trakoščan is an artificial accumulation which occurred when the dam was built in the middle of the 19th century within the Romanticist restoration of the entire Trakoščan complex. According to cartographic records, a small water feature had previously existed at this site, probably a fish-pool in the area of the upper part of the present lake.

The lake is fed by the water from the streams that flow down along the surrounding hill-sides, with the Čemernica stream as the most significant. From its very beginning the lake had two functions: economic – as a fish pond, and aesthetic – as a decorative part that was a usual feature within Romanticist park architecture. Behind the dam, water from Lake Trakoščan flows as a stream, and enters the River Bednja.

EDUCATIONAL TRAIL TRAKOŠĆAN „PUT VILA“

Na stazi oko Trakošćanskog jezera uređena je poučna staza koja pruža uvid u prirodne vrijednosti park-šume Trakošćan i okolnog područja. Duzine je 5 km, a može se razgledati uz lagani šetnju za otprilike 2 sata. Na njoj se nalazi 20 poučnih točaka, kao i ribarska kućica koja je uređena kao info-čokica namijenjena predaju za vrijeme šetnje.

Priču o jedinstvenim prirodnim vrijednostima ovog područja ispričat će vam vila... Pitale se...zašto baš vila? EDUCATIONAL TRAIL TRAKOŠĆAN „THE FAIRIES PATHWAY“

The educational trail is 5km long, surrounding Lake Trakošćan – 5 km long which can be enjoyed by taking a light walk for about 2 hours. There are 18 educational points on the trail and also one information desk.

The story about this unique natural assets of the area will be told by the fairies...

Why fairies you may wonder? Maybe it's because we would all somehow like to believe in the invisible and unknown, the mysterious and hidden, fairytale-like and magical. Or perhaps because our everyday lives lack the things that are surreal, magical and fairy-like. All of this is here beside you, you simply have to open your eyes.

Take a walk along the fairies pathway and pay attention to the tiny, miraculous, seemingly invisible details around you. A sudden flash of the sun, a dew drop, a flower of amazing colours, a branch of an unusual shape, a mysterious sound or even an obscure shadow. Is this the work of fairies?

Dive into the mysterious world of nature, breathe in the smell of the forest, listen for the unfamiliar sounds, feel the breath of wind on your face, carefully observe the world around you and maybe it will be you of all people who captures a glimpse of a fairy and discovers that fairies truly do exist.

Once you discover the magical world of fairies, you will never look at nature around you through the same eyes.
